About Us

Jungle Medical Missions Uganda (JMMU) is a faith-based, fully registered not-for-profit medical missions organization founded in 2012.

We use the practice of medicine as a platform to share the gospel of Jesus Christ and we believe that restored health is fundamental for one to achieve their God-given potential.

Inspired by our Christian faith, we support people from all backgrounds, regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, or political affiliation.

We provide highly subsidized, quality healthcare services to less privileged people in highly critical and vulnerable communities in Uganda, and parts of East Africa through our mobile community outreach clinics.





Our History

In 2012, Jungle Medical Missions conducted its first mission to Kampala's heavily populated slums, Namuwongo, Kisenyi, and Ndeeba. During the mission, a group of volunteers examined around 45 children. In order to help treat ringworm in these impoverished regions, antifungal lotions were given out along with barbers who were brought in to shave the heads of children.

A sensitization effort was started with the same aim to teach slum inhabitants and parents about good hygiene habits. But our team's ongoing presence in the community slums helped us get more familiar with the unevenness of the health care system in rural areas as well as the haphazard and ad hoc approaches to healthcare in these communities.

Hope Missionary Hospital

We established Hope Missionary Hospital in Tororo District to provide a broad range of medical services for the underprivileged communities around the border district. Hope Missionary Hospital is well equipped to handle health care beyond primary health care. This community hospital operates with 18 staff members, both clinical and non-clinical staff. The hospital expanded its scope of services to offer optimal management of sickle cell disease, radiography, and blood transfusion.

First Community Hospital is the second community hospital we established and started operations in December 2023. With only seven months of operating, there have been great strides for the hospital. Located in Kasanje subcounty, it serves a population of over 40,000 people in 7 parishes and 33 villages.

She's a Hero

Through this program, underprivileged mothers are supported throughout antenatal, intrapartum, and postpartum care to mitigate the three delays, thereby reducing the maternal mortality rate in Uganda. With partnerships, we can reach out to various communities, working hand in hand with local leaders who help us identify vulnerable mothers.

Our main target group is the victims of rape, defilement, and domestic violence, as well as the vulnerable mothers in the slums of the Kampala district and villages around our community hospitals. Once registered, JMMU provides ANC, health education, hygiene, nutrition, birth preparedness, ultrasound scans, laboratory services, and the provision of mama kits. Medical and physical support is given to the mother throughout pregnancy until six weeks after delivery so as to make sure both mother and child are safe and the file is closed.





Community Medical Outreaches

JMMU conducts community medical outreaches regularly in the most vulnerable communities of Uganda. These are always supported by volunteers from around the world, bringing specialized medical care to the most disadvantaged communities in Uganda.
